Licensing Objectives

Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10) *

We will operate the premises responsibly and in accordance with all relevant legislation. All staff will be trained in licensing laws, age verification procedures, and health & safety. Clear signage will be displayed regarding responsible behaviour, noise control, and the prevention of anti-social behaviour. CCTV installed and maintained, and records will be kept as required. We will work with local authorities and the police to ensure the premises operate in a safe and compliant manner.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder *

A comprehensive CCTV system will cover all customer areas, entrances, and exits, recording 24/7 and retained for at least 31 days. Incident and refusals logs will be maintained and made available to police or licensing officers upon request. We will ensure good lighting around the premises and monitor the external areas to discourage loitering.

c) Public safety *

The premises will comply with all health & safety regulations, fire safety standards, and have clear emergency exits with appropriate signage. All staff will receive training in fire evacuation procedures and first aid. Capacity levels will be monitored to avoid overcrowding. Fire extinguishers and safety equipment will be maintained regularly. We will not be serving any alcoholic drinks.

d) The prevention of public nuisance *

Clear notices will be displayed asking customers to leave quietly and respect neighbours. Music will be kept at reasonable levels, and doors/windows will be closed during regulated entertainment. Deliveries and waste collections will be scheduled at reasonable hours to minimise disturbance. Any complaints from neighbours will be logged and addressed promptly. Staff will monitor the outside area to discourage noise and anti-social behaviour.

Licensing Objectives

e) The protection of children from harm *

All staff will be trained to recognise and refuse service to underage individuals and to record any refusals in the incident/refusals log. Children will only be allowed on the premises when accompanied by a responsible adult. No entertainment or materials unsuitable for children will be provided or displayed on the premises. We will cooperate fully with authorities and adopt additional measures if required to protect children from harm.
