
My Account – Council Tax

How to register for My Account


Go to the council website and click on the My Account icon




Select the link to **Manage your Council Tax online**




Scroll down the next page and find '**Start now**'. You will need to select this if you have never registered for Croydon My Account.




Once you have selected '**Start now**' it will take you to the sign in page for My Account. You will need to select '**Create an account**'




Once you click on Create an account it will ask for an email address. Once you enter your email address you must then click on 'Email me a code'. A 6-digit confirmation code will be sent to you by email. Please check your junk/spam folders if you think you haven't received it.



Once you receive your code you will be asked to input this to start the registration and then click 'Next'. If you did not receive the code, you can request another by clicking 'Request a new code'




You will need to choose a password and input your name. You must confirm you have read the councils privacy notice and terms & conditions. Then click on 'create an account'



You are now registered for a My Account and will be taken to the Council tax services page to register your Council Tax account.


How to register to see your Council Tax account on My Account

To register for Council Tax, you will need to click on the 'View your account details'




You must then input your details (person or organisation). At this stage you can enter the name you want to use for the online Council Tax account or as they appear on your bill.

Once this has been completed click 'NEXT'




If you have a benefit claim, you can select to register for both Council Tax and Benefits.



You will be asked to authenticate your Council Tax details first. At this stage you must enter your first name and last name as per your bill/registered on your Council Tax account, your Council Tax account number and property postcode before clicking 'Authenticate'

If you had selected to register both Council Tax and Benefits, you could choose to skip the Council Tax authentication and go straight to Benefits authentication. This will mean you cannot view your Council Tax account until you authenticate your details.




If you get this message after inputting your details, this means your details do not match the Council Tax system. If this happens, please tell us via www.croydon.gov.uk/contact-us/message-us and select MyAccount or Online services help and then Council Tax online service. Please provide your Council Tax account number, name and property address.


You have entered incorrect details. Please try again. You have 2 attempts remaining.

If you have also selected to register for Benefits, after authenticating your Council Tax details, you will be asked to authenticate your Benefit details. You must be the claimant and will need your National Insurance number and claim number details to hand.

If you choose to skip to registration, you will not be able to view your benefit claim until you authenticate your details.




Once you have authenticated your Council Tax details and where applicable, Benefit details, you will need to input your email address and choose whether to sign up for paperless billing. We recommend signing up as we'll email you as soon as you have a new bill ready to view online. No waiting for a bill in the post!



Once you click submit, the Council Tax service will be added to your My Account.



For added security, when you click 'continue' before being able to view your account, you will need a one-time pass key which is sent to your email.



Once you receive the code to your email, you will need to enter the details to view your account.
