ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

BINGHAM ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the installation of an entry treatment and kerb and footway works, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements and parking in Bingham Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the works are taking place:
 - a) Bingham Road will be closed between its junction with Shirley Road and the common boundary of Nos. 180 and 182 Bingham Road.
 - b) Parking within the closure area will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
- 3. The Order will come into operation on 24 November 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 07 December 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 4. Whilst the closure is in place the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Lower Addiscombe Road, Shirley Road and reversed.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
- (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
- (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
- (c) any vehicle involved in carrying out the specified works.
