PROPOSED BUS GATE – LODGE LANE, CROYDON The Croydon (Prescribed Routes) (No. F47) Traffic Order 20-

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make the above Traffic Order under Section 6 and 124 of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce a bus gate in Lodge Lane, cutting through the central reservation, sited opposite the exit to Addington Village Bus Station, to allow buses to turn right.
- 3. A copy of the proposed Order and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET. Alternatively, all documents can be obtained by email request to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.

- 6. The Order is intended to introduce a bus gate in Lodge Lane to allow buses to turn right. These proposals are part of a bus priority scheme aimed at improving bus network efficiency and reducing delays.
