PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

MORLAND ROAD, CROYDON – AT ITS JUNCTION WITH
STRETTON ROAD

Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that they propose to install a new zebra crossing in the above road as specified in the Schedule to this Notice to provide safe crossing facilities and improve road safety for school children and other pedestrians.

The general effect of the zig-zag markings would be to prohibit all vehicles from stopping on the markings for any reason and to improve road safety by aiding pedestrians to cross safely.

Morland Road outside No. 22 - The crossing point will be 6.6 metres wide. The zig zag markings will extend for 17.5 metres either side of the crossing point. Existing single yellow lines will be removed to accommodate the new crossing.
