TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER
VERY CHRISTMAS CROYDON EVENT – HIGH STREET, CROYDON
ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Very Christmas Croydon event they have made an Order the effect of which will be to close part of High Street, Croydon.
2. During the event, the cycle lane in High Street, Croydon, will be closed between its junctions with Park Street and Katharine Street.
3. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.
4. Whilst the closure remains in force, cyclists will be asked to dismount and walk through the closure on foot. Alternatively, cyclists can use the diversion routes below.
 - Via Mint Walk, St George's Walk, Park Street, Park Lane and George Street.
 - Via Park Street, St George's Walk and Katharine Street.
5. The Order will come into effect at 9am on 05 December 2025 and will remain in force until 10pm on 07 December 2025.
6. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - a) any vehicle involved in setting up or dismantling the said event.
 - b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
