ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED

WEST STREET, CROYDONTEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate mains decommissioning works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in West Street, Croydon.
2. During the work West Street will be closed between its junctions with High Street, Croydon and Wandle Road.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Wandle Road, Queen Street, Church Road, Lower Coombe Street and High Street.
4. The Order will come into operation on 02 March 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 15 March 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
