SURREY STREET ROAD, CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate works to the entrance to Surrey Street Market, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic in Surrey Street.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Surrey Street will be closed between its junction with Scarbrook Road and the north-western boundary of The Market Tavern, Surrey Street.
3. During the closure, the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below. Residents' access will be maintained.
 - Via Scarbrook Road, Charles Street, Church Street, Reeves Corner, Tamworth Road and Frith Road.
 - Via Church Street, Reeves Corner, Roman Way, Old Town, The Croydon Flyover, Park Lane, Katharine Street, and High Street, Croydon.
4. The Order will come into operation on 20 April 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 24 April 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used to carry out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
