ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991  
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

MERSHAM ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate Openreach duct laying works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic and parking in Mersham Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
  - a) Mersham Road will be closed from the common boundary of Nos. 106 and 108 Mersham Road to the common boundary of Nos. 140/142 and 144/146 Mersham Road.
  - b) Parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time on both sides of the road outside Nos. 100 to 130 and Nos. 111 to 151 Mersham Road.
  - c) One-way working in Mersham Road (between Hythe Road and Livingstone Road) will be suspended to allow two-way traffic.
3. The Order will come into operation on 20 March 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. During the closure, the diversion route of traffic will be via Hythe Road, Livingstone Road and Mersham Road, and vice versa.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) a vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
