ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14

NORTHBOROUGH ROAD, NORBURY

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate sewer cleaning works on behalf of Thames Water, they intend to make an Order to the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Northborough Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Northborough Road will be closed between its junctions with London Road and Palmers Road.
3. During the works the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Northborough Road, Wide Way, South Lodge Avenue, Galpins Road, London Road and vice versa.
 - Via A23, Norbury Crescent, Strathyre Avenue, A23, Galpins Road, South Lodge Avenue, Wide Way and Northborough Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 23 March 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 27 March 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
