ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991  
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

TAVISTOCK ROAD & TAVISTOCK GROVE, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate drainage works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements and parking in Tavistock Road and Tavistock Grove.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
  - a) Tavistock Road will be closed at its junction with St James's Road.
  - b) Parking on the south-east side of Tavistock Grove will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time between its junction with St James's Road and the common boundary of Nos. 2 and 2a Tavistock Grove.
3. During the works the alternative routes for diverted traffic will be via St James's Road, Wellesley Road, Bedford Park, or via Bedford Park, Sydenham Road, and St James's Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 23 March 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on approximately 25 March 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) A vehicle involved in the said work.
  - (b) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
