ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
PAMPISFORD ROAD, PURLEY
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate carriageway surfacing works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking on Pampisford Road, Purley.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Pampisford Road will be closed outside Nos. 35 to 49 Pampisford Road.
3. Parking within the closure area will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
4. The Order will come into operation on 02 April 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed overnight from 8pm on 02 April to 5am on 03 April 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. Whilst the closure is in place, the alternative routes for traffic will be as detailed below. Access to properties for delivery purposes will be maintained.
 - Via A23, A235, B275 and reversed.
 - Via B275, Purley Way, and reversed.
6. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
