ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991
GOODWIN ROAD & GOODWIN GARDENS - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF
VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate excavation works to install a flow meter and strainer, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic on Goodwin Road and Goodwin Gardens, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Goodwin Road will be closed from its junction with Goodwin Gardens to the common boundary of Nos. 31 and 33 Goodwin Road.
 - b) Goodwin Gardens will be closed between its junction with Goodwin Road and a point opposite the south-eastern flank wall of No. 1 Goodwin Gardens.
3. Whilst the closure is in place the diversion routes for traffic will be via Goodwin Road and Waddon Way.
4. The Order will come into operation on 23 April 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within approximately twelve days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
