

**PN17 - CROYDON COUNCIL**  
**PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF EXISTING DISABLED PARKING BAYS**  
**RAYMEAD AVENUE, THORNTON HEATH**

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and (Free  
Parking Places) (No. H10) Order 20-  
The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No. H11) Order 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Orders would be to amend the two existing disabled persons parking places operating “at any time” in Raymead Avenue, adjacent to the flank wall of No. 770a London Road, to become three-hour maximum stay disabled bays.
3. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected Monday to Friday inclusive, from 16 April 2026 until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET. 4. Persons desiring to object in relation to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Design Team, Croydon Council, Floor 3, Zone C, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon CR0 1EA or email Parking Design (address above) quoting the reference PD/H10 & H11 by 07 May 2026.
5. The proposed Orders are intended to amend two existing “at any time” disabled parking bays in Raymead Avenue to become three-hour maximum stay disabled parking bays. The change is intended to benefit visitors and shoppers by ensuring a turnover of vehicles so that these spaces regularly become available.
