

DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES – SCHEDULE 254

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and (Free Parking Places) (Amendment No. H8) Order 20-

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. H9) Order 20-

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

1. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

- a) **Revoke the disabled parking places in the vicinity of: No. 5 Colebrook Road, Norbury, No. 15 Osterley Gardens, Thornton Heath, No. 317 Violet Lane, Croydon, No. 6 Westleigh Avenue, Coulsdon, and No. 31 Windmill Road, West Croydon.**
- b) **Designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.**

Biggin Way, Upper Norwood	Outside No. 26
Grove Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 4 and partially cross the frontage of No. 6
Handcroft Road, Croydon	Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 17 Sumner Road (replaces a length of a single yellow line)
Harewood Gardens, South Croydon	Outside No. 40
Hunter Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 33
Hythe Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 83 (replaces one space in a partial footway bay)
Kennelwood Crescent, Croydon	Outside No. 56
Kingswood Avenue, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 24 (replaces a one-space shared use payment/permit bay)
Malcolm Road, South Norwood	Outside Nos. 38 and 40
Norbury Court Road, Norbury	Outside No. 19
Norton Gardens, Norbury	Outside No. 53
Penshurst Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 53 and partially across the frontages of Nos. 51 and 55
Queen Elizabeth's Gardens, New Addington	Outside No. 14 and partially across the frontage of No. 16 (partial footway bay)
Raymead Avenue, Thornton Heath	Outside No 19
Reddown Road, Coulsdon	Outside No. 10a and partially across the frontage of No. 10 (replaces one space in a resident permit holders' bay)
Sutherland Road, Croydon	Partially outside Nos. 64 and 66 (replaces one space in a shared use payment/permit bay)
Tylecroft Road, Norbury	Outside No. 54 and partially across the frontage of No. 52
Tavistock Road, Croydon	Outside Westburn Court, No. 25 Tavistock Road

2. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET.
