The premises will operate as a hot food takeaway and restaurant. The management will ensure all licensing objectives are promoted through responsible operation of the business. CCTV is installed at the premises and staff will be trained in safety, hygiene and customer management. The premises will comply with all relevant health and safety and licensing legislation.

Licensing Objectives

b) The prevention of crime and disorder *

A comprehensive CCTV system is installed and maintained at the premises covering all public areas and entrance points. CCTV recordings will be retained for a minimum of 28 days and made available to police or authorised officers upon request. Staff will monitor customer behaviour and refuse service to any person displaying aggressive or disorderly conduct.

c) Public safety *

The premises will maintain appropriate fire safety equipment including fire extinguishers and fire alarms. Emergency exits will be kept clear at all times. Staff will be trained in emergency procedures and health and safety requirements. The premises will comply with food safety and hygiene regulations.

d) The prevention of public nuisance *

Clear signage will be displayed requesting customers to respect local residents and leave the area quietly. Waste will be stored and disposed of responsibly. Noise levels from the premises will be controlled to minimise disturbance to neighbouring properties.

e) The protection of children from harm *

Children will be permitted on the premises only when accompanied by a responsible adult. The premises will operate in accordance with all safeguarding requirements. Staff will remain vigilant to protect children from harm at all times.
