ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14  
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991  
MOORE ROAD, UPPER NORWOOD  
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate carriageway and kerb works, they have made an order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Moore Road, Upper Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
  - a) The eastern (odd-numbered) side of Moore Road will be closed outside Nos. 31 to 55 Moore Road.
  - b) Parking outside Nos. 31 to 55 Moore Road will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply “at any time”.
3. During the closure, the alternative route for traffic will be via Crown Dale, Bradley Road, and Beaumont Road. Access to properties will be maintained.
4. The Order will come into operation on 05 May 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 17 May 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
