ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14  
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT  
1991  
BLENHEIM GARDENS & CRANLEIGH GARDENS, SOUTH CROYDON  
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement work by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic in Blenheim Gardens and Cranleigh Gardens, South Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
  - Blenheim Gardens will be closed between its junction with Cranleigh Gardens and the common boundary of 16 Cranleigh Gardens and 13 Blenheim Gardens.
  - Cranleigh Gardens will be closed from the common boundary of Nos. 15 and 16 to the common boundary of Nos. 17 and 18 Cranleigh Gardens.
3. The alternative routes for vehicular traffic during the closure will be via Limpsfield Road, Addington Road and Onslow Gardens, or via Limpsfield Road and Sanderstead Court Avenue.
4. The Order will come into operation on 18 May 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 01 June 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
