PUBLIC FOOTPATH 661
(EXTENDING BETWEEN CLIFFORD ROAD
AND CARMICHAEL ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works to clear overgrown vegetation, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian movements on Footpath No. 661, South Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Public Footpath No.661 will be closed between its junctions with Carmichael Road and Clifford Road.
3. Whilst the closure is in force, the alternative route for pedestrians will be via Carmichael Road, Clifford Road and reversed.
4. The Order will come into operation on 19 May 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed within one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 6 months to be reintroduced if further work is necessary.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a person involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a person attending for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
