ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

SYDENHAM ROAD AND BURDETT ROAD, CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate drainage works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Sydenham Road and Burdett Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Sydenham Road will be closed at its junction with Selhurst Road and Northcote Road.
 - b) Parking will be suspended on the south-west (even numbered) side of Burdett Road and waiting and loading restrictions will apply "at any time".
3. During the works the diversion route for traffic will be via Burdett Road, Northcote Road, and reversed, or via Northcote Road, Gloucester Road and Gladstone Road. Access for residents will be maintained.
4. The Order will come into operation on 18 May 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 22 May 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used to carry out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
