This variation application seeks to extend the start time for sale of alcohol and opening hours by one hour to 9am each day (currently 10am) and amend the start time for the opening hours non standard timing for New Years Eve permission to reflect the earlier start time sought. There is no change to terminal hours for sale of alcohol or opening hours and no change to other licensable activities which remain as existing. We

With regards to the earlier hours sought for sale of alcohol and opening to start from 9am each day (currently 10am), the applicant does not believe these proposed hours will have any negative impact on the promotion of the licensing objectives and has vast experience of operating many licensed premises to this earlier start time for sale of alcohol and opening and has demonstrated it can do so without issues of note and whilst continuing to promote the licensing objectives.]
