We will be looking to communicate more with the local public, authorities and enforcement teams as much as possible to keep the safety of the local community as priority. A new fascia to the shop as the per conservation officers request with a wooden frontier and interior gridded shutter will make the premises look more approachable and take account history of the community. We want to be more involved in the community of South Norwood, and be part of safekeeping in the area.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will be updating our CCTV system to make public aware that safety instore and in the frontage is priority, as we had local enforcement teams requesting our help with footage for

	various crimes in the area previously. More cameras will be installed and recording will be stored for a minimum required period of 31 days.
c) Public safety	Public safety will be improved by better lighting and cleanliness of the store as it will be completely refurbished.
d) The prevention of public nuisance	Changing the shutter to be gridded internally behind the glass shop front gives the shop a neater appearance and less graffiti applied in public. Not serving known street drinkers who cause public nuisance is also something we would like to do, although this has already reduced in the past few years.
e) The protection of children from harm	Implement more staff training to enforce more Challenge 25, EPOS recognition of age restricted products will protect children of harm.
