The premises will operate as a small lounge bar providing the sale of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises. The venue will include a main seating area, bar service counter, DJ area for recorded music, customer seating, toilet facilities, and an external smoking area located outside the premises. The premises will operate with a focus on a relaxed social environment with music and seating rather than a high-capacity nightclub. CCTV will be installed throughout, and the layout includes clearly marked fire exits and safe customer flow.

The premises will operate as a small, well-managed lounge environment with a focus on seated customers, controlled capacity, and responsible alcohol service. The management will promote all four licensing objectives through staff training,

	<p>clear policies, and regular monitoring of the premises. CCTV will be installed throughout key areas including entrance, bar, seating areas and exits. Staff will be trained in licensing law, conflict management and responsible service. The premises will operate with a dispersal policy and maintain good communication with local authorities where required</p>
b) The prevention of crime and disorder *	<p>A comprehensive CCTV system will be installed and maintained, covering all entry and exit points, bar area and customer seating areas, with recordings retained for a minimum of 31 days and made available to police upon request. Staff will be trained to identify and refuse service to intoxicated individuals. An incident log will be maintained and kept on site. A Challenge 25 policy will be enforced to prevent underage sales. The premises will operate a zero tolerance policy towards drugs, violence and anti-social behaviour.</p>
c) Public safety *	<p>The premises will comply with all fire safety regulations, including clearly marked fire exits and maintained escape routes. Maximum occupancy levels will be controlled to prevent overcrowding. Regular safety checks will be carried out on equipment and the premises. Staff will be trained in emergency procedures, including evacuation. First aid provision will be available on site</p>
d) The prevention of public nuisance *	<p>Measures will be taken to minimise noise disturbance to nearby properties. Music levels will be controlled and doors/windows kept closed during regulated entertainment. A dispersal policy will be in place to ensure customers leave the premises quietly and in an orderly manner. Clear signage will be displayed requesting customers to respect local residents. The smoking area will be managed to prevent noise nuisance and monitored by staff.</p>
e) The protection of children from harm *	<p>A Challenge 25 policy will be strictly enforced, requiring valid photographic ID for anyone appearing under the age of 25. Acceptable forms of ID will include passport, driving licence or PASS card. Staff will be trained in age verification procedures. Children will not be permitted on the premises during late hours. The premises will not host activities that are unsuitable for children.</p>

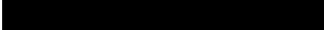
