The applicant will take overall responsibility for ensuring all the measures below are implemented successfully The Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) will be contactable at all times. Staff will be trained before being allowed to sell alcohol. The premises will cooperate fully with Metropolitan Police and other responsible authorities. A written staff training record will be maintained and signed by staff members.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder *

A comprehensive CCTV system will be installed and maintained, covering all entry/exit points, tills, alcohol and tobacco display areas. CCTV will record continuously and recordings will be retained for a minimum of 31 days. A trained staff member will be on duty at all times who can operate the CCTV system and provide footage to police upon request. An incident log will be maintained and made available to responsible authorities, recording crimes, disorder, refusals, and any interactions with police. A refusals register will be kept and regularly reviewed by management. High-strength beers, lagers, and ciders above 6.5% ABV will not be stocked (except premium/specialist products). Alcohol will be displayed in a designated area behind or within clear view of the counter. The premises will operate a till prompt system to remind staff of age verification checks.

c) Public safety *

The premises will comply with all relevant health and safety legislation and display poster. Fire safety equipment will be installed and regularly maintained. Clear and unobstructed emergency exits will be provided at all times. Appropriate lighting inside and outside the premises will be maintained. Staff will be trained in emergency procedures, including evacuation. Keep emergency exits clear: Never block exit routes or fire escapes with stock or displays. Maintain clear visibility: Keep windows uncluttered and ensure adequate lighting inside and outside the store. Improve visibility in blind spots and corners to deter theft or unsafe behaviour. Keep floors dry and clutter-free: Prevent slips and falls with clear signage for wet areas. Emergency items: Keep a stocked first-aid kit and fire extinguisher accessible and up to date.

e) The protection of children from harm *	<p>Noise to be controlled to prevent disturbance to nearby residents Doors and windows kept closed Refuse sale of alcohol to individuals where it is identified the individual is intoxicated or consuming excessive alcohol or drugs Prominent signage will be displayed requesting customers to leave quietly and respect local residents. No noise-generating activities (e.g. loud music) will take place. Deliveries and waste collections will be arranged at reasonable hours. A litter patrol will be conducted in the immediate vicinity of the premises. The area outside the shop will be kept clean and free from litter.</p> <p>Alcohol & age-related products (e.g. tobacco) will be positioned to allow staff supervision The premises will operate a Challenge 25 policy. Any person who appears under 25 will be required to provide valid photographic ID (passport, driving licence etc.). Clear signage regarding age restrictions will be displayed. All staff will receive documented training on age-restricted sales, which will be refreshed regularly. Alcohol will not be sold to anyone who is intoxicated or acting on behalf of a minor.</p>
