ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14, AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
MANCHESTER ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

1. Croydon Council **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate utilities installation work, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Manchester Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Manchester Road will be closed between its junction with Heath Road and the common boundary of Nos. 20 and 22 Manchester Road.
3. During the works, the alternative routes for diverted traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Heath Road, Luna Road, and St Paul's Road.
 - Via Heath Road, Norfolk Road, and St Paul's Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on the 08 June 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 14 June 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
