ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991  
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS  
PLOUGH LANE, PURLEY  
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements and parking in Plough Lane, Purley.
2. During the work:
  - a) Plough Lane will be closed to vehicular traffic between its junction with Russell Hill and the common boundary of Nos. 40a and 42 Plough Lane.
  - b) Parking in Plough Lane will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time along the entire length of the road, on both sides.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for traffic will be via Foxley Lane, Woodcote Road, Stafford Road, Purley Way, Purley Road and Banstead Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 23 May 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 31 May 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such an extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle or person involved in conducting the said work.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
