DIXON ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telecommunications works, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic in Dixon Road, South Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Dixon Road will be closed at its junction with Whitehorse Lane.
3. During the closure the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Whitehorse Lane, Nugent Road, Elm Park Road and vice versa.
 - Via Whitehorse Lane, Whitworth Road, Oliver Avenue and Dixon Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 22 June 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed within three days. However, the Order will remain in force for a maximum duration of 18 months to be reintroduced if further work is required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (c) a vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
