ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

VINCENT ROAD & CHIPSTEAD VALLEY ROAD, COULSDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telecoms' civils works and the replacement of a telephone pole on behalf of O2, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit parking on Vincent Road and Chipstead Valley Road, Coulsdon.
2. During the works parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions prohibiting parking and loading will apply at any time in the following locations.
 - a) Vicent Road – on both sides of the road between its junction with Chipstead Valley Road and the common boundaries of Nos. 8 and 10 and Nos. 7 and 9 Vincent Road.
 - b) Chipstead Valley Road – outside Nos. 294 to 306 Chipstead Valley Road.
3. The Order will come into operation on 22 June 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 26 June 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
