ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED

NORBURY CRESCENT, NORBURY

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate paving and kerb works they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements and parking in Norbury Crescent.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place: -
 - a) Norbury Crescent will be closed between its junctions with London Road and St Helen's Crescent.
 - b) Parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time within the above closure area.
 - c) One-way working in Norbury Crescent between its junctions with London Road and St Helen's Crescent will be suspended to allow two-way traffic.
 - d) Vehicles will be banned from turning into Norbury Crescent from London Road.
3. During the closure, the diversion routes for vehicles will be via Norbury Crescent, St Helen's Road and London Road, or via London Road, St Helen's Road and St Helen's Crescent.
4. The Order will come into operation on 10 August 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within four days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle involved in the said work.
 - (b) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
