The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and
(Free Parking Places) (No.14) Order 2026

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.14) Order 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 10 August 2026 made the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

1. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

- a) Revoke the disabled parking places in the vicinity of: No. 36 Elliott Road, Thornton Heath, No. 95 Fairlands Avenue, Thornton Heath, No. 119 Gonville Road, Thornton Heath, No. 10 Lancing Road, Croydon, and No. 66 Mayfield Road, Thornton Heath, and No. 111 Silverleigh Road, Thornton Heath.
- b) Designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.

Brooklyn Avenue, South Norwood	Outside No. 2 (partial footway bay)
Chipstead Valley Road, Coulsdon	Outside No. 357
Dunsfold Way, New Addington	Adjacent to Nos. 1-23 Walton Green
Falkland Park Avenue, South Norwood	Outside No. 26
Fawcett Road, Croydon	Outside No. 33 and partly outside No. 31 (replaces one space in a shared use permit/payment bay)
Ferndale Road, South Norwood	Outside No. 44 and partially across the frontages of Nos. 42 and 46
Garston Lane, Kenley	Opposite No. 21 (partial footway bay)
Kynaston Avenue, Thornton Heath	Outside Nos. 103 and 101 (replaces one space in a shared use permit/payment bay)
Malvern Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 61
Mayfield Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 57
Mersham Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 56
Milne Park West, New Addington	Outside No 50 and partially across the frontage of No. 52
Nugent Road, South Norwood	Outside No. 39 (partial footway bay)
Oswald, Court Wood Lane, Croydon	Outside No. 266 in the inset parking bay
Oval Road, Croydon	Outside No. 138 and partially across the frontages of Nos. 136 & 140
Queen Mary Road, Upper Norwood	Outside No. 19 and partially across the frontage of No. 17
Shirley Park Road, Croydon	Outside No. 64
Warlingham Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 61

2. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 17 August 2026, and of all associated Orders, can be inspected between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET for a period of six weeks from the date the Orders were made. Alternatively, all related documents or further information can be requested by email to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.
3. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
