ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT
1991

CAIRO NEW ROAD, CHURCH STREET & GEORGE STREET, CROYDON
TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a trial allowing trams to travel in the opposite direction to the one-way working in Cairo New Road, Church Street and George Street, Croydon, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily suspend the one-way working restrictions for trams in those streets.
2. Whilst the said trial is taking place, one-way working will be suspended for trams in the following sections of road:
 - a) Cairo New Road from the northern boundary of Arcadia House, Cairo New Road to its junction with Church Street.
 - b) Church Street from its junction with Cairo New Road to its junction with George Street.
 - c) George Street from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Wellesley Road.
3. The Order will come into operation on 16 August 2026, and it is anticipated that the trial will be completed on 21 August 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should it be required.
4. The restriction specified in paragraph 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such an extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
5. The suspension of the one-way restriction shall only apply in respect of trams involved in the said trial.
