ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
NORMAN AVENUE, PURLEY BURY AVENUE, PURLEY DOWNS ROAD,
PENWORTHAM ROAD, & YEW TREE WALK, SOUTH CROYDON & PURLEY
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement work by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic on the above roads.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place the roads/sections of road below will be closed in phases from 03 September 2026.

Road Name	Closure Location
Norman Avenue	Entire length
Yew Tree Walk	At its junction with Purley Downs Road
Purley Downs Road	Outside Nos. 54 to 96a
Purley Bury Avenue	At its junction with Purley Downs Road
Penwortham Road	At its junction with Purley Downs Road

3. Whilst the closures are in place the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Norman Avenue Westbound: Via Purley Downs Road, Riddlesdown Road, Brighton Road, Sanderstead Road, and Florence Road.
 - Norman Avenue Eastbound: Via Purley Downs Road, Penwortham Road, and Purley Oaks Road.
 - Yew Tree Walk: Via Brancaster Lane, and Purley Bury Avenue.
 - Purley Downs Road: Via Brighton Road, Purley Road, Godstone Road, Downs Court Road, Mitchley Avenue, Rectory Park, Sanderstead Hill and vice versa.
 - Purley Bury Avenue: Via Brancaster Lane, and Yew Tree Walk.
 - Penwortham Road: Via Victoria Avenue, and Norman Avenue.
4. The Order will come into operation on 03 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed within approximately thirteen weeks. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
