ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14, AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
LONDON ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

1. Croydon Council **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate redundant water supply disconnection work, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in London Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The cycle lanes on both sides of London Road between its junction with Whitehall Road and the southern boundary of No. 727 London Road will be closed.
 - b) The western (odd-numbered side) footway opposite No. 728 London Road will be closed.
3. During the works, cyclists will be diverted into the main carriageway. Pedestrians will be diverted into a walkway in the carriageway.
4. The Order will come into operation on the 26 September 2026, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 27 September 2026, with back-up dates of 03 and 04 October 2026 if the works are delayed. The Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle or person involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
