The below calendar of activity is intended to support **road safety co-ordinators** in primary schools who run the Junior Travel Ambassador (JTA) scheme, providing an overview of what JTAs should be doing in each half term. The **A5 JTA guides*** provided with your resources should be used to help your JTAs create their assemblies and to run activities - in this booklet there are also extra activities the JTAs can run if they want. Some activities will be prepared for you, and all your JTAs need to do is promote it. A checklist of the annual activities has also been provided for you to help keep track of progress. Most activities listed here can be recorded as indiviual stories on STARS, and you will likely be very close to achieving Bronze level STARS accreditation. **You should update STARS every half term.**

*A5 JTA guides should not be written on by the pupils. Pupils should not retain guides, badges or hi-vis vests at the end of the school year as these are the schools property and to be used with each group of JTAs. Hi-vis vests and guides will NOT be replaced. Badges will only be replaced where level of accreditation changes. Certificates in the back should be photocopied if you wish to use them annually.
