

Norbury Library Update – October 2020



The external roofing works are now complete and the scaffolding is being removed from the outside of the building.



The interior roofing panels are being cleaned to ensure so that they can once again flood the library with natural light.



On the ground floor, the computer room is taking shape, and the doors have been fitted to the new study area. In the photos below, you can also see the refurbished wood and glass screen between the two rooms:
