- Open+ technology will be introduced to extend the opening hours for library members who have registered. This is a system that allows users to enter the building with their card and a pin when the library is unstaffed. You will be able to sign up when the library has re-opened.
- In order for the work to be carried out, we will need to close the library at 5.00pm on Saturday 1 June. The new-look library will re-open at 9.00am on Saturday 3 August. During the library closure a "pop-up" library will be available at certain times in the building foyer. Details will be advertised later in May.
