- Following a competitive tendering process and contract award to the preferred bidder in August 2018, the provider is unable to provide sufficient assurance of continuity of service delivery from 1st November 2018. This is a statutory service and the Council must act to ensure it can fulfil its obligations and ensure continuity of service delivery to vulnerable children and families.
- The existing framework contract, which it is proposed to vary and extend to secure continuity of this service, expires on 31st October 2018
