	The aim of transformation programme is to provide individually and personalised supported housing solutions which encouraged rights, independence and inclusion to people with learning disabilities. It is a review of existing services that started to be implemented in 2007. The process involves moving away from registered residential care, respite and day services as, towards supported housing.
