PROPOSED PUBLIC REALM IMPROVEMENTS – LONDON ROAD, CROYDON

The Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.Y68) Traffic Order 20-

The Croydon (North) (Parking Places) (No.Y69) Traffic Order 20-

The Croydon (Goods Vehicles) (Free Parking Places) (No.Y70) Traffic Order 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make Traffic Orders under the Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Orders would be:-
 - to revoke four 2 hour 'pay and display' only parking places on the north-east side of London Road opposite No. 89 and on the south-west side of London Road opposite Nos. 156/160, opposite Nos. 238 to 232 and outside No. 183 London Road;
 - to introduce one additional 2 hour 'pay and display' only parking place and readjust the positioning and sizes of existing 2 hour 'pay and display' only parking places on both sides of London Road, between the north-western boundary of No. 89 London Road and the junction with Hathaway Road, to accommodate the introduction of kerb build outs. The bays would operate between 9am and 5pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive and charges for parking in the bays will vary from no charge for up to 30 minutes to £4.50 for 2 hours (maximum);
 - to introduce a loading bay of 15 metres in length outside Nos. 186 to 192 London Road for the use of goods vehicles only for the purpose of loading or unloading goods/delivering or collecting goods between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday, for a maximum of 30 minutes;
 - to introduce 'At any time' waiting and loading restrictions in London Road between the north-western boundary of No. 89 London Road and the junction with Sumner Road.
3. Copies of the proposed Orders and of all related Orders, of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of the plans which indicate each length of road to which the Orders relate, can be inspected between 9am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders were made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, at the Enquiry Counter, 'Access Croydon' Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Services, Place Department, Croydon Council, P.O. 6. The proposed Orders are intended to facilitate public realm improvements in London Road, as part of the London Road Public Realm improvements. The measures are intended to improve the environment of the public realm for all road users. Specifically in order to accommodate wider footways and inset parking bays the proposed orders will relocate some of the parking arrangements in London Road.
