PROPOSED ONE-WAY WORKING AND CYCLE CONTRA FLOW  
BEVERSTONE ROAD AND MAPLETHORPE ROAD, THORNTON HEATH  
The Croydon (Prescribed Routes) (No.Y83) Traffic Order 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make a Traffic Order under Section 6 and 124 of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Order would be:**
  - (a) **to introduce one-way working north-westbound in Beverstone Road, with no entry from Malvern Road and an exemption to apply to pedal cycles;**
  - (b) **to introduce one-way working south-eastbound in Maplethorpe Road, with no entry from Colliers Water Lane and an exemption to apply to pedal cycles.**
3. A copy of the proposed Order and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, Surrey, CR0 1EA.

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Services, P.O. Box 1462, Croydon, CR9 1WX or email [Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk](mailto:Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk) quoting the reference PD/CH/Y83 by 14 October 2015.
6. The Order is intended to introduce one-way working with an exemption for pedal cyclists in the roads detailed. This proposal would be introduced to reduce congestion and the potential for collisions. Exemptions for pedal cycles are applied where there is sufficient road width to allow a cycle contra-flow to operate safely.
