The Croydon (Free Parking Places) Disabled Persons (No.Y89) Traffic Order 20-**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders would be to:-**
  - (a) **remove two shared use (permit/pay and display) parking spaces in Clarendon Road adjacent to the Derby Road Baptist Church to accommodate two new limited stay disabled parking bays;**
  - (b) **introduce two limited stay disabled bays with maximum stay of 3 hours in Clarendon Road adjacent to the Derby Road Baptist Church and in Castle Hill Avenue outside the surgery at No. 1a Castle Hill Avenue;**
  - (c) **introduce two unlimited stay disabled parking bays outside the new development at 27 Parker Road.**
3. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, between 9am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Highways & Parking Services, P.O. 6. The proposed Orders are intended to introduce or amend various types of parking bays. The limited time disabled bays are being introduced to enable disabled churchgoers and surgery patients to park near their destinations. The unlimited stay disabled bays are being introduced outside a new development as part of the planning conditions.
