PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF FREE PARKING BAYS - FERNWOOD, CROYDON

The Croydon (Fernwood) (Free Parking Places) (No.Y93) Traffic Order 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders would be to:-**
 - (a) **introduce five shared use (permit/pay and display) bays with a two hour maximum stay in Station Approach Road, Coulsdon, adjacent to the Trinity Square development;**
 - (b) **relocate eight shared use (permit/pay and display) bays with a two hour maximum stay outside the new primary school site in Aberdeen Road to accommodate a new loading bay. The bays would be moved north-eastwards and partly relocated on a section of yellow line protecting a vehicular access that will be redundant once the new school is complete;**
 - (c) **introduce a loading bay opposite No. 8a Aberdeen Road operating from 9am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday with a maximum stay of 30 minutes outside the new primary school site;**
 - (d) **remove free parking spaces from the bend in Fernwood, Pixton Way adjacent to Nos. 13 to 23 Friars Wood, Pixton Way (to be replaced by double yellow lines) and introduce a new free parking bay for one vehicle in Fernwood, adjacent to No. 144 Middlefields, Pixton Way.**
3. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, between 9am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Highways & Parking Services, P.O. Box 1462, Croydon, CR9 1WX or email Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk quoting the reference PS/CH/Y90, Y91, Y92 and Y93 by 25 November 2015.
6. The proposed Orders are intended to introduce or amend various types of parking bays. The new shared use bays are being introduced to provide more parking in Station Approach Road. The shared use bays in Aberdeen Road are being relocated to accommodate a new loading bay. Some free parking spaces on the bend in Fernwood, Pixton way are being removed to assist larger vehicles negotiating the bend, and a new free parking space is being introduced nearby in Fernwood to partially replace the spaces that are proposed to be removed.
