1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make Traffic Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders would be to:-**
 - (a)(i) **revoke the existing pay and display parking bays and introduce a new layout of pay and display parking bays in Central Parade, New Addington, with a maximum stay of one hour (free for 30 minutes), operational from 8am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday, as detailed in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and**
 - (ii) **revoke the existing disabled parking bays and introduce limited time disabled bays with a maximum stay of 3 hours in Central Parade, New Addington, as detailed in Schedule 2 to this Notice; and**
 - (iii) **introduce 4 new loading bays in Central Parade, New Addington, operating from 8am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday with a maximum stay of 30 minutes for vehicles whilst loading/unloading and a no return time of 1 hour as detailed in Schedule 3 to this Notice.**
3. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.

6. The proposed Orders are part of a public realm improvement scheme intended to create a high quality public space which promotes environmental performance and provides accessible and safe routes for transport.
