AMENDMENTS TO WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS - BLACKHORSE LANE, COOMBE
LANE, HIGHER DRIVE, GOAT HOUSE BRIDGE, SPRING LANE BRIDGE,
TENNISON ROAD BRIDGE AND WOODCOTE GROVE ROAD
THE CROYDON (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (NO.Y16) TRAFFIC ORDER 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make the Croydon (Weight Restriction) (No.Y16) Traffic Order 20- under Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act, 1985.
2. **The general effect of the Order would be to prohibit vehicles (with the exception of buses) exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight from proceeding:-**
 - (a) **on the bridge in Blackhorse Lane from the party wall of Nos. 43 and 45 Blackhorse Lane north-westward for a distance of 38.00 metres;**
 - (b) **on the railway bridge in Higher Drive between its junctions with Beaumont Road and Foxley Hill Road.**
3. **The general effect of the Order would also be to remove the existing weight restrictions from Coombe Road, Goat House Bridge, Spring Lane Bridge, Tennison Road and Woodcote Grove Road.**
4. A copy of the proposed Order, of the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order and of maps indicating the lengths of roads to which the proposed Order relates can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order is made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, at the Enquiry Counter, 'Access Croydon' Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.

6. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Services, P.O. Box 1462, Croydon, CR9 1WX or email Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk quoting the reference PS/CH/Y16 by 08 April 2015.
7. The proposed Order is intended to introduce a ban on vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight from using bridges in Blackhorse Lane and Higher Drive (as specified) with an exemption for buses, following bridge inspections and structural assessments. The proposed Order is also intended to remove existing weight restrictions from Coombe Road, Goat House Bridge, Spring Lane Bridge, Tennison Road and Woodcote Grove Road.
