1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the proposals detailed in the above-titled public advertisement, which appeared in the Croydon Guardian and London Gazette on 25 February 2015, have been amended and that Croydon Council intends to make Traffic Orders based on these amended proposals under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the amended Orders would be to:-**
 - (a)(i) **relocate two of the originally proposed limited time disabled bays (with a maximum stay of 3 hours) in Central Parade as detailed in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and**
 - (ii) **omit the originally proposed loading bays in Central Parade from the proposal, as detailed in Schedule 2 to this Notice.**

Note: All other proposed parking arrangements detailed in the above titled public advertisement would remain unchanged.
3. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, between 9am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.
