INTRODUCTION OF EXEMPTION FOR PEDAL CYCLES TO EXISTING NO ENTRY
AND ONE-WAY RESTRICTIONS – NORTH END, CROYDON
THE CROYDON (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO.1)
EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 2015

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 01 June 2015 made the above-mentioned Traffic Order under Sections 9 and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Order would be to exempt pedal cycles from the existing no entry and northbound one-way restrictions that apply in North End, Croydon, on an experimental basis.**
3. A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 15 June 2015, of the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order and of a map indicating the length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected until the expiration of a period of six months from the date on which this Notice is published during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.
4. Copies of the Order may be obtained from Parking Services, Place Department, P.O. Box 1462, Croydon, CR9 1WX.
5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
6. The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order made under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Any person may object to the making of the Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of six months beginning with the day on which the experimental Order will come into force or, if the Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force. Any such objection must be in writing and must state the grounds on which it is made, quote the reference number DP/CH/Y50 and be sent to the Order Making Section, Parking Services, Place Department, P.O.Box 1462, Croydon, CR9 1WX.
