COULSDON FARM AND GILBERT COURT ACCESS ROAD,
OFF LION GREEN ROAD, COULSDON

The Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.Y47) Traffic Order
20

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council, proposes to make the above Traffic Order under Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Order would be to introduce waiting restrictions operating “at any time” throughout the week in the access road which extends from the south-western kerb-line of Lion Green Road to the entrance to Coulsdon Farm.**
3. A copy of the proposed Order and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "Access Croydon" Facility, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Highways & Parking Services, P.O. Box 1462, Croydon, CR9 1WX or email Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk quoting the reference DE/CH/Y47 by 24 June 2015.
6. The Order is intended to introduce 'At any time' waiting restrictions in the length of road specified. This is necessary in order to remove obstructive parking and ensure access to properties.
