

Space standards for single family dwellings

Room size (m2)	Max no. of occupants
Less than 6.5	See note below
6.5	1
10+	2

- 1. No more than 2 persons to occupy a bedroom.
- 2. As a guide, children up to the age of 10 may share a room if they are of different sexes. Children/adults (siblings) up to the age of 21 may share a room if they are of the same sex.
- 3. A typical box room which comfortably fits a single bed may be accepted if it is below 6.5m², if adequate storage is available elsewhere.
- 4. Open plan kitchen/diners, kitchen/living rooms or living rooms are not acceptable as sleeping accommodation. The exception to this is for studio flats. See point 5.
- 5. Measurements taken of studio flats should only include the habitable space available and not the floor area of the kitchen or en-suite bathroom in the calculation.
- 6. Permitted number of occupants, as specified on the licence (once an inspection has been carried out) will not take account of the age/sex of the current or future occupants.
