# Apply by Sunday 24 February 2019

The Croydon Young Mayor's Fund is a scheme where the Young Mayor is offering to support projects and ideas that are designed by young people aged 8-18 who live, study or work in Croydon.

Croydon young people can apply for up to £2,000 to fund short-term projects, celebrations, trips and equipment that will benefit other young people and their communities in Croydon.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Groups of young people who are aged 8-18 and live, go to school (or college or work) in Croydon
- Groups of young people that have an adult sponsor with access to a business bank account, company or community organisation.

### HOW TO APPLY IN FOUR SIMPLE STEPS

- 1. Think of a great idea. Share it with friends, groups you attend and adult organisations that support you to see if they think it could work. This will give your idea credibility give you confidence to apply.
- 2. Work out what your project needs and how you would spend up to £2,000
- Complete, check and return your completed funding application form to youngmayor@croydon.gov.uk by no later than midnight on Sunday 24 February 2019
- **4.** If your application is selected, you will be invited to pitch your idea to the Young

Mayor on the week commencing **Thursday 7 March 2019** to stake your claim to the funding!
