Cocaine

'Crack' Cocaine

'Magic Mushrooms'

'Ecstasy'

LSD

Amphetamines (including 'Crystal Meth')

### Borough Commander Chief Superintendent Adrian Roberts:

"We will act swiftly on any intelligence about people dealing, taking or making illegal drugs, and police officers will work with the council to close those properties down and bring those involved to justice. If you report someone, we are on your side and we will follow it up. If you are taking or dealing drugs, you will face the consequences."

#### Cabinet Member for Housing, Councillor Dudley Mead:

"This is a warning to anyone who uses or deals drugs in their properties. If you are a council tenant you run the risk of losing your home because we will not tolerate drugs. You may also not be re-housed because you may have made yourself intentionally homeless. There is no excuse for not knowing this can happen – you have been warned."


